



## ROZELLE P. BATEMAN - THE FATHER OF SHERIDAN

Rozelle P. Bateman was born September 3rd, 1828, in Jefferson Co. N.Y. He received his education in Clinton Institute, N. Y., and at the early age of nine-teen commenced teaching school, a vocation he followed twelve years in New York State, after which he moved to Wisconsin and engaged in teaching, when he was elected Superintendent of public instruction. His next move was to Michigan, where he held the same position. From there he came to Minnesota, and here taught school in winter, farming in summer. In 1848 he married Hannah Poppleton and had one daughter and named her Hannah Ellen. He lost his first wife by 1850 and went on to marry in 1856 to Ellen A. Crowfoot and had seven more children



with this marriage. In the late 1850's Mr. Bateman landed in the great mining fields of Montana, remaining in Alder Gulch six months, and working in the mines by the day. He then moved to the Home Station and kept the place one year for Ben Holliday, making \$2,200. After this he went on to Fish Creek and engaged in farming and dairying for eight months. In May of 1864 he secured a deed and mortgage for a farm of 160 acres on Mill Creek for \$11,000 and the following spring put in a crop of forty acres. In 1867 he received the appointment of postmaster, keeping the mail in a cigar box, and he dubbed the fledgling community "Sheridan," in honor of famed U.S. Army General Phillip Sheridan. At the same time, he made his start in the mercantile business located where Walters Family Foods now stands with a few overalls and shirts and a little tobacco and an informal hotel. He continued to put a little more ground under cultivation from season to season, also to add to his lands and goods, and at one time had a stock of goods valued at \$20,000, owning 1,280 acres of land on which the town site of Sheridan is located. In 1871, Bateman received, though the use of preemption, the patent to the 160 acres of land on which his buildings stood and constructed a new, two-story log cabin, moving his store and the post office into the new building. (Where High Peaks Federal Credit Union and the Sheridan Liquor Store now stands.) In 1876 Winthrop Raymond married Mr. Bateman's daughter, Hanna and in 1889 Mr. Raymond purchased the Bateman Ranch and Mr. Bateman and his wife moved to Washington State but held on to some of the land for the town of Sheridan with a mortgage secured from

town of Sheridan with a mortgage secured from Mr. Raymond and became partners with a Mr. Samuel Word from Helena and Mr. W.A. Clark of Butte. In 1894 Mr. Raymond sued Mr. Bateman for defaulting on a loan to build the town of Sheridan. The court ruled in Mr. Raymond's favor with Mr. Bateman owing Winthrop Raymond \$14,000. Mr. Bateman appealed, and the case was heard all the way up to the Montana Supreme Court where they sent it back to the Virginia City Courts to go over numbers again. The case was settled out of court in May of 1894 in Mr. Batemans favor with Mr. Raymond paying \$11,000 to Mr. Bateman because Mr. Raymond just added his name to the deed with no agreement from Mr. Bateman or partners. By August of 1894 Mr. Raymond bought back the deed for the town of Sheridan for \$11,000 from Mr. Bateman and his partners Mr. Samuel Word and

W.A. Clark and continued to sell lots to create the thriving town of Sheridan.

thriving town of Sheridan. Rozelle Bateman passed away in November 25, 1901 and is buried in Portland, Oregon. He is the father of Sheridan, as he did name the town and started the first mercantile. He was also once an elected county commissioner for the county. Actually the town of Sheridan has two men that helped Sheridan become what it is today, the father (Mr. Bateman) and the pioneer (Mr. Raymond).
