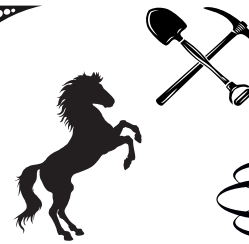

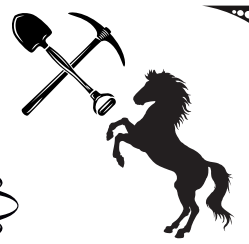

THE MYSTERY OF PLUMMERS GOLD



Henry Plummer

Montana's mountainous areas are historically full of stories of hidden treasures which make our state to be known as the "Treasure State". Several books and publications have been written about Plummer's gold that draw treasure hunters to our surrounding areas.

It's estimated that in four months, Henry Plummer and "the innocents" killed more than 120 miners and stole what today would be around \$6 million in gold. In December of 1863, George Ives and other members went too far and started what is called today as Vigilante justice. A well-liked young man named Nicolas Tybalt was murdered and his death spurred on the start of "necktie parties". Only seven months after the Road Agents had begun their reign of terror, Henry Plummer marched to a scaffold he himself had built as his role as a sheriff. But before he was hanged, he made an unusual request; if given two hours on a horse, he would return with his

weight in gold. The vigilantes had already heard enough and hung Henry Plummer without

allowing him to reveal the secret of where his treasure was buried. Upon his death, people began to search all around Bannack and the Alder Gulch hoping to find just a glimmer of the stolen gold. A number of people have come forward claiming to have found Plummer's treasure, but no evidence has been produced to support their claims. The question is did Henry Plummer bury stolen gold in one place, or did he bury several caches in different locations? Of course it wasn't just Plummer that was supposedly robbing gold from the miners and travelers. Other men were getting their cut too! Treasure hunters, historians, and experts believe that there is more than just Plummer's treasure buried in history. Plummer had more than 100 associates who would have received a cut from the stolen gold. They were the insiders that worked within the postal system or within freighting company's that sent word of mouth of gold shipments. It's believed that most of his associates who were arrested and hanged without revealing where they hid their share of the loot. Here is a list of some of the treasure supposedly buried in and around Montana said to be taken by Henry Plummer and members of his gang:

\$12,000 in gold dust stolen on October 13, 1863

\$2,800 in gold stolen on October 26, 1863

\$1,000 in gold and treasury notes stolen on November 22, 1863

\$5,000 in gold dust stolen in November 1863

\$80,000 in gold dust and \$1500 in treasury notes stolen in December 1863

It has been said that treasure was buried at the ruins of an old town named Hell Gate that's located 2 miles northwest of Missoula, Montana. In 1850 Hell Gate had a population of 2,000 residents. Before the demise of Plummer and gang members in 1864, it's said that Henry and 6 of his men buried a cache of gold coins and nuggets somewhere near the town. The town is now a ghost town with the ruins of some buildings.

Another location in the history books is that he buried \$650,000 worth of gold bullion near Haystack Butte, Montana along the Missouri River. This gold has never been found although many have searched for it over the years. Haystack Butte is located off of State Highway 89 in Teton County. There are also other tales that Plummer and his gang buried \$800,000 worth of gold bullion and coins in a cave on Hollow Top Mountain. This mountain is located about 7 miles northeast of Waterloo, Montana.

It is also said that gold could be found in the Lost Rock Bandit Cache in which the Plummer gang was said to have robbed a stagecoach and got away with \$75,000 in gold bullion. The gang buried the gold above the town of Spencer in a canyon called Beaver Canyon in Clark County Idaho.



Robbers' Rock, a landmark and rendezvous of Plummer's men a few miles out of Bannack. Pioneers of the gold days passed this place with their hands on their guns, ready for battle.

Stories are also found that states that part of Plummer's gang hid \$500,000 in gold bullion in a cave behind a waterfall on the Snake River. This is now located about two miles southwest of the American Falls Reservoir Power company.

For a time, Plummer lived near Sun River, 20 miles from Great Falls, Montana. Plummer apparently buried his portion of the gold near a small creek located 200 yards from the house. In 1875, a young boy was digging in the soft ground near a stream at Sun River and found one of Plummer's bags of coins. He returned to the area with his father, but was unable to relocate the spot.

Stories have appeared in several books and publications in Montana and throughout the United States of buried cans filled with gold coins and where they "might" be found.

The mystery of Henry Plummer's lost treasure was detailed in a May 2, 1990, episode of "Unsolved Mysteries."

Though several people have claimed to have found the gold, there has never been confirmation of its finding, or even of its existence.

Some historians have made the argument that Plummer was not an outlaw, nor did he lead an organized gang. But for those who do believe that Plummer was a gang leader, also believe in the legend of buried gold and the mysterious locations that have yet to be found.

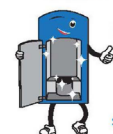
