COLONEL WILBUR FISK SANDERS "THE OTHER COLONEL SANDERS"



Did you know that at one time Madison County had a Colonel Sanders? No, not the KFC man. Let me tell you about Wilbur Fisk Sanders, a famous US senator and an ambitious and courageous young attorney.

He was born May 2, 1834, at Leon, New York and at the age of 20 Sanders moved to Akron, Ohio, to study law under the tutelage of his uncle, Sidney Edgerton. Sanders proved to be an eager and talented student of the law (he was admitted to the Ohio Bar in 1856). In 1858, Sanders married Harriet Peck Fenn at Tallmadge, Ohio.

Upon the outbreak of the Civil War, Sanders quickly responded by helping to organize a battery of artillery and a company of infantry to serve the Union Army. During the Civil War, he recruited a company of infantry and an battery of artillery in the summer of 1861 and was commissioned a first lieutenant in the 64th Regiment, Ohio Infantry, of which he was made adjutant. He assisted, in 1862, in the construction of defenses along the railroads south of Nashville. When his term of enlistment expired, he resigned from the army.

After the war Wilbur F. Sanders returned to Akron where he resumed his law practice with his uncle, Sidney Edgerton. In March of 1863, his Uncle was appointed as Federal Justice for the newly created Idaho Territory. Sanders made plans to accompany Edgerton to the territorial capital at Lewiston, Idaho. The Edgerton and Sanders families left Akron on June 1, 1863, for the Idaho Territory.

En route to Lewiston, the wagons of Edgerton and Sanders detoured to Bannack. Although they would later attribute this deviation to a concern that winter weather might have closed in on them before reaching Lewiston, one can reasonably speculate that learning of the gold discoveries at Bannack and Virginia City provided an even greater influence. The Edgerton and Sanders families finally arrived at Bannack on September 18, 1863. Sanders wasted little time in hanging out his shingle, made of paper. As he later reminisced, as recorded by the Anaconda Standard, July 23, 1905, "I got an office at Bannack, a log cabin which was occupied by a friend of mine...[and] I got a piece of brown paper out of a grocery store and took it down to a wagon and with axle grease made a law sign out of it—put my name on it and added the words 'Law Office' and tacked it up on the front of the store, and went to practicing law."

Sanders had concluded some business in Virginia City and on the morning of December 19, was prepared to board the A.J. Oliver stage back to Bannack when he was approached by a messenger on behalf of John & Mortimer Lott, then prominent merchants in Nevada City. Sanders subsequently met with the Lott brothers and agreed to serve as the prosecuting attorney against George Ives, John Frank, and George Hilderman who were charged for the murder of young Nicholas Tbolt.

The trial of the first of the notorious road agents and murderers, George Ives, was held in Virginia City on December 21, 1863. He successfully prosecuted Ives. After the conviction, it was Sanders' motion that the sentence be carried out immediately, rather than waiting until the next day, even though darkness had fallen. Ives was taken to a partially completed building selected for the site of execution and hanged that same evening. The famed quote attributed to Sanders "Men do your duty," was part of his execution speech.

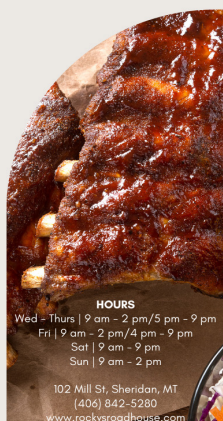




