



ANNA LOWMAN-PANKEY ~ LOCAL TEACHER & DENTIST

Dr. Anna Mae Lowman Pankey was born in Virginia City Feb. 13, 1876, a daughter of J. B. Lowman and Anna May Conway Lowman, pioneer residents'. J.B. Lowman arrived in Virginia City in 1865 looking for gold and ended up working as a carpenter helping to build many buildings still standing in Virginia City. Here he created a full and interesting life for his family of five boys and Anna. She had attended school in Virginia City where she was granted a teacher's certificate at graduation. On Christmas Eve in 1895 she married Mr. Edward F. Hall but sadly he had passed away by 1898. Anna went on to teach school in Iron Rod, Sheridan and Ruby. She was elected as County Superintendent of Schools from 1898 and served for the



county until 1908. For a few years she was Ruby Schools' principal from 1909 through 1911. In 1911 Anna entered and won a "In Standard's" contest that was concluded by the Anaconda Standard newspaper. For this contest in the local paper there was a full-page ad with a coupon and nominate yourself or a friend of yours as a candidate for a Standard 1910 Krause Piano. The ad stated "Do you know of a young lady musically inclined who lacks an instrument on which to devote her talent? You can help her without cost to either yourself or her". She won the \$500 piano that year. In 1912 Anna moved to Portland, Oregon where she would go to Dental College and graduated in 1914. By 1916 she moved back to Virginia City and met and married Dr. Mark Pankey a local dentist who was the son of a part owner of the Easton Mine, Emmett Pankey.

She was the first woman to take and pass the Montana State Dentist exam. Anna and her husband then practiced dentistry in Virginia City and Ennis. On October 16,1919 Mark Pankey passed away leaving her to carry on the business for the Madison County residents. In 1939 and under the Federal writers' project, she completed a "A Fine History of Madison County", which she wrote for the Montana State Encyclopedia. This write up includes not only a complete history of people and places, but also an exhaustive description of the county's physical features, including points of interest in

each town and other portions of the county. A talented and energetic woman, Dr. Pankey was active in community affairs not only serving

others, but helping local community members with their education and health. She was a member of women's clubs in Ennis and Virginia City, a talented

musician, a long time teacher and a educator and the first Montana woman Dentist. Dr. Pankey died in her Virginia City home January of 1951 at the age of 74. She had no children of her own, but there were many fond memories from the school children that were lucky to have her as their teacher. Funeral services were held at St. Marys Catholic church in Laurin and she was buried in the Virginia City cemetery.
