





Henry Elling worked hard to create his life story from "rags to riches". At one time, this immigrant was not only a store clerk, but later a store owner, president of six banks around the state and so much more. Mr. Elling was born in Prussia, Germany on December 9th, 1842. His parents passed away when he was only 15 leaving him in charge of a younger brother. With courage and a head full of dreams he gathered up his little brother to find their older brother in the land of opportunity. The two boys made an exceptionally long trip finding their brother in Missouri where they settled, learned english and worked on a farm. A young Henry Ellis found work soon after in a small town mercantile. This would be the foundation and education for a successful future. In 1861 he moved to Leavenworth, Kansas for a short time looking to start a business, but tales of a gold rush caught his attention and he moved on to Denver, Colorado in 1862.

He found a job as a store clerk in a clothing business and earned enough to purchase a stock of goods and decided to move on to Virginia City in the Montana Territory. There he opened a store in 1864. After only a year he moved on to Helena where he started a new clothing store and found himself dealing mainly with gold dust. At first, he was extraordinarily successful, but prices dropped, and his business ended in failure, so he moved back to Missouri to start over. In 1869 he returned to Virginia City and opened another Mercantile business on Wallace Street where he would meet Mary B. Cooley, an Ennis schoolteacher. They would marry on July 20, 1870, buy a lot for \$65 in Virginia City and build a beautiful home out of stones from the local



quarry that still stands today. In this home they would also grow their family to 10 children. By 1873 Mr. Elling established the Banking House of Henry Elling, a private bank. His business was based on his personal experience with his customers and his extensive knowledge of dealing with gold dust. He then started to organize banks in several other communities such as the Carbon County Bank in Red Lodge, the State National Bank of Miles City, the Bank of Fergus County and the Union Bank and Trust Company of Helena. In 1899 Mr. Elling renamed his bank in Virginia City to the Elling State Bank which continued to operate long after he passed away under the management of Mr. Buford, his wife Mary Elling and son Karl Elling. By 1875 in addition to his banking business, he still owned and operated his mercantile business, started a cattle ranch, went into the flour mill business (one of which was the Silver Springs Flour Mill), a quartz mill, a gold mining claim, and started a hardware business. He had registered over 80 pages in Madison County making him the largest landowner in the area. Included were ranch and farmlands, mining claims, city lots and buildings.

In late 1900 Henry Elling fell ill and four days later he died of pneumonia on November 14. After his death, Mary would expand their home to include a ballroom for social events. She would also provide most of the funds for a 1902-1903 construction of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Virginia City. After Mary's death in 1924, the house was used as a boarding house

for several years before going vacant. In the early 1960's the property was acquired by Charlie Bovey who used the house for the storage of some of his "treasures". Toni James acquired the property in 1996 and restored the home. In November of 2008, the Elling House Arts & Humanities Center was formed

ties Center was formed as a non-profit entity and negotiated a lease with Ms. James for the use of the Elling House. The Center now seeks to continue the tradition of using this historic property as a venue




