

WINTHROP RAYMOND - THE FOUNDER & PIONEER OF SHERIDAN



'Wint" Raymond, as he was more generally known to the old-timers and his many friends, was one of the honored pioneers of Montana. He was identified with affairs of importance, was the essential founder of the thriving little city of Sheridan, Madison county. He was born in Cincinnati, 0H. on Oct. 22, 1847. His father, Daniel E. Raymond, was a native of Connecticut, and descended from a family established in New England in 1732. 1865 in his sixteenth year he crossed the plains with a wagon train and his mother, brother William and sister. They had two yoke of

oxen, a yoke of cows and a span of horses. The oxen pulled the wagon on which they brought their provisions and the horses were attached to a light wagon which the mother and sister rode. They were nine months making the journey. Some of the trip was very enjoyable and at other times it was attended with great danger and often troublesome. On part

of the journey they traveled ninety miles without water and during this time some of the members of the wagon train they traveled with as well as some of their cattle had perished. It on was the 7th of September 1865 that they arrived in Virginia City. His mother went on to start a boarding house and his sister Sarah began teaching school in March, 1866 as probably the first public school teacher in an organized school district in the Montana Territory. Winthrop and his brother started a business hauling wood and rock in and about Virginia City. He transported stone for many buildings that are still standing in Virginia City, then a vigorous mining camp. By 1868 he furnished material for the erection of the quartz mill at Summit, in Alder gulch, and there after carried on freighting between Summit and Corinne, Utah. In 1871 he established a successful wholesale merchandising business again with his brother in Virginia City. In 1880 Mr. Raymond and brother disposed of the business and turned their attention to banking. They had the honor of being the first bankers of the town calling it Raymond Harrington & Co. Winthrop later would sell his interest in 1888 to Amos C. Hall, the new firm being Hall & Bennett. The brothers also owned Bellmont Park, where they engaged in importing and breeding full blooded horses and were prominent factors in this line and to them is due the credit of having been the importers and owners of several of the finest trotters in Montana. After being



engaged in this business for a number of years, the Winthrop sold his interest in Bellmont Park to his brother In 1889 and he went on to purchase the Bateman ranch, (Currently where Sherian is) built Sheridan State Bank, became bank president and platted the town site of Sheridan in 1890. He placed the lots on the market, thus becoming the founder of the town of Sheridan. He also had 1,600 acres of fine ranch property upon which he raised high grade short horn cattle and standard bred horses. His ranch property occupied much of his time and attention in his later years. Mr. Raymond married Miss Hannah E. Bateman on Feb. 28, 1876 and they went on to have a son, Wolcott Raymond and three daughters named Delliah, Carrie and Mary. Winthrop always had a deep interest in any matter or project pertaining to the growth of Sheridan where he made his home. He made loans to those in need and those struggling to make a start with no questions asked. He was respected

and trusted by all those who knew him. He was also known to be brusque, plain spoken, honest and frank and always considered his fellow man's feeling and beliefs. As a pioneer his name is associated

with the early history of Montana. One of his last remarks before he passed away was "Montana to me is one of the great promising states of the future, with her mineral and agricultural wealth, her stock raising and other resources, she will eventually take the lead over all other states and will come to the front" Winthrop Raymond passed away quietly in his home in Sheridan on September 3rd, 1912 and was buried in the Sheridan Cemetery.

Our goal is to generate \$340,000 to build a 2,800 sq. ft. addition to create more room for social distancing, new technology, resources, classes, and exhibits. The Discovery Hall will also provide much needed space for growing the Library's circulation and archives.
