Friends and neighbors,

Montana isn't just where I live, it's who I am. Families don't get to print more money when times get tight; we cut back, get creative, and find a way through. Trevor believes the state should do the same.

He also believes in focusing on what truly matters, good schools, safe communities, strong families, and the freedom to live our lives without constant interference from bureaucrats and special interests. Common sense tells us that strong communities come from strong families, and strong families come from opportunity, faith, and local control, not more red tape.

At the end of the day, we want the same thing most of you do: a Montana where our kids can afford to live, work, and raise their own families. A place where neighbors look out for each other, where government remembers who it serves, and where the people still come first.

That's why Trevor is running, not for power or position, but to restore something we've all been missing: good old-fashioned Montana common sense.
