It seems that these days, we all at one time or another are buying stuff online, whether from Amazon or from any of the other multitude of online sites. And with those purchases comes the inevitable return. Wrong size, wrong item, damaged in delivery, or whatever, there are many reasons for returning the items we just purchased. Sometimes this process can be complicated and confusing. Here at Beacon Business Center we would like to make the process easier for you.

The first step in this process is to understand that we are not a UPS store, we are a UPS Authorized Shipping Outlet and A Fedex Authorized Ship Center. Therefore, if you are processing a return and do not want to drive to Butte (UPS) or Bozeman (Fedex) do not choose any shipping option that gives you a bar code rather than an actual shipping label. Unfortunately the bar codes only work at the corporate stores.

In the case of Amazon, when processing a return, the first shipping option they give you is for the UPS Store. Again, if you do not want to drive to the closest UPS store which is in Butte, do not choose this option but rather choose the second option which says UPS drop off. This will allow you to print an actual shipping label and you can then drop it off at our location. If you have already printed the barcode, an easy fix is to go into your account, cancel the return, redo it and choose that second shipping option. If printing is an issue for you, email the label to beaconbus@ gmail.com and we would be happy to print the label and have it ready for you.

We hope this will make the process easier for you and please remember that along with processing UPS and Fedex shipments for you, we are always happy to take you prelabeled drop-offs as well. If you still have questions, feel free to give us a call at 842-7488.




BACK TO SCHOOL

As the future of what school will look like hangs in the balance, we thought it would be worthwhile to take a glimpse into some of the first organized schools in the Ruby Valley.

In the winter of 1864, the Montana Post's editor-in-chief, Thomas Dimsdale, opened Virginia City's first subscription school. This is a type of private school funded by parents who paid only for the number of days their child(ren) attended school. While an average of 81 students were enrolled, the attendance averaged 50 - 60 students daily in a small log cabin. They began using the basement of St. Paul's church as the cabin quickly became too crowded.

One of the student's during that time, Mary F. Gohn, recalls her experience there, "We didn't have

grades, Youngsters started in the small seats on one side of the room and as they grew, they moved to larger desks, progress ing from one side to the other side of the room. When they got to the other side of the room, they usually quit school and



went to work. It wasn't very often a youngster was 'graduated' as having learned as much as the teacher could teach him. If one stayed in school long enough, he would be taught trigonometry and other advanced math taught now in college."

Public School District No. 1 was organized in January of 1866, though they were not able to open the doors until March due to inclement weather. The children attended school throughout the summer until August 17. Back then, school terms were 100 days or 5 months. In 1867, Montana's first "graduated school system" made of Primary, Elementary, and High School was built. It was made of brick and was the largest building in town.

Nevada City opened Public School District No. 2 in November of 1869. There were 12 boys and 14 girls ranging in age from 6 to 18 years old. Many of those children remained in Madison County and became county leaders. Adobetown (located in Alder Gulch) opened its doors to 33 students in 1873 as School District No. 3. It often collaborated with the school in Virginia City due to lack of funds. Students' favorite events were spelling contests. The county-wide spelling bee was held in Adobetown. Robber's Roost was centrally located and became Public School No. 4 until it closed it's doors and consolidated with Sheridan School in 1944. District 6 was the Lower Wisconsin Creek School. The exact date of its inception is unknown, but it consolidated with Twin Bridges in 1936, one of the last small country schools to do so. The steps of the school still remain to this day.

> In 1866 the first log schoolhouse was raised in Sheridan on upper Water Street. It was one room with a dirt roof. rough boarded floors, and high windows with tiny panes. As in Twin, the seats and benches were homemade. The education levels ranged from 1st grade through about 5th grade. Children came from the surrounding country at

a distance of up to two miles. The more advanced pupils attended school in Virginia City or Deer Lodge. Sheridan's first school was opened by a Mr. Muffly, later Judge Muffly of Virginia City, Sheridan felt that they had quite a pretentious building when the frame one was erected in the early 1870's. The entire school was conducted by one teacher up till the year 1890. In 1893, Sheridan became Public School District No. 5.

From the Valley's humble beginnings, educating our children has always been a priority. We appreciate all of the efforts of those who have been involved in educating the community throughout the years. And, look hopefully toward the future of continuing that legacy.
