#### THE HISTORY OF TRAVEL IN THE RUBY VALLEY (SERIES 3 & 4 AF 4)

The inspiration for this Ruby Valley transportation series came from learning that there was an airfield in Sheridan at some point. Researching the facts about the origins of the Twin Bridges and Sheridan airports has proven to be a bit daunting. It appears that there were federally funded and then municipally funded airports in both towns. The Sheridan municipal airport was approved in January of 1934, but it seems that airfield activity had already been occurring as early as 1928. Instead of writing a historical article, we decided to share some articles and photos. Kathy Bayers, daughter of deceased local pilot, Byron Bayers, remembers picking rocks off of the dirt runways in Sheridan. She recalled sitting with her mom in their car on the runway one evening with headlights on and her dad landing right in front of them with no lights on!

An exhibition was given at the Twin Bridges air port Saturday evening. At this time Keith Seidensticker, son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Seidensticker, who has been a sludent at the Butte Aicraft school during the summer; made a solo flight. Bert Mooney, instructor, gave some stunt flying and piloted a plane from which Irwin Westa student, made a parachute jump.

Sheridan Gets Airport

Chairman Julian of Sheridan reported that Sheridan's plans for a municipal airport had been approved by Fred Sheriff, state supervisor of aeronautics, and an allotment of federal funds for construction made for \$4,500. Of this sum, \$4,200 will be used for labor, and \$300 for materials.

work on the field was to commence at once, with Jack Speedy in charge and unemployed men from that community doing the labor. It was expected that between 40 and 60 men would benefit by the project.

The air port is to be constructed on what is known as the Fred Tilton field, south of the Raymond residence and east of the Vigilante Trail at the edge of the town. Under the terms of the federal grant of funds for construction of the field, the town is to take a lease on the property for a term of not less than five years.

Local Plans Rejected

Bert Mooney, chief engineer for the Montana aeronautic commission, was unable to report favorably on Virginia City's proposed airport site, so that the proposition was not approved. The site, which was the only one available in this vicinity, was entirely unsuitable for landing and not exceptionally good for taking off, according to Mooney, noted Butte aviator.
