

The Ruby Valley Reruns funds several Merit Scholarships to support community, university, technical college, and other post-secondary education. The scholarship fund has been established to assist the further education of Ruby Valley students interested in the medical field. The medical field includes any aspect of nursing, emergency medicine, patient care and the healthcare industry. The scholarship for 2026 will be available for educational entrance or continuation in 2026. Three scholarships valued at up to \$2,500 per year will be awarded in 2026. A selection panel of Reruns Board Members determines recipients based on academic qualifications, career goals, and letters of reference.

- Must have at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average
- Must be a resident of the Ruby Valley

### Application Requirements

- Essay: Statement of Aspirations and Educational Goals (not to exceed two typewritten, double-spaced pages)
- Two letters of recommendation – one from a teacher and the other from someone who is not related to the applicant and is not an Auxiliary member
- Copy of transcripts

### Selection Criteria

- Academics (20 points)
- Community Service/Activities (10 points)
- Financial Need (20 points)
- Essay: Statement of Aspirations and Educational Goals (30 points)
- Letters of Recommendation (20 points)

Award Amount: Three awards up to \$2500

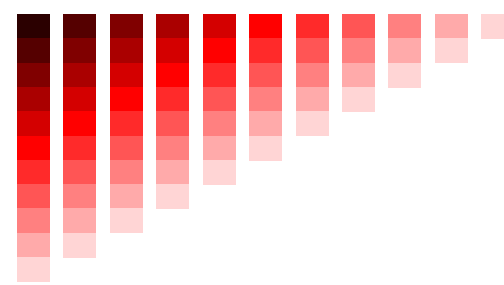
