






BLUE ANCHOR & THE COOK FAMILY

Jemima Montana Bateman Cook was born May 29th, 1909 in Butte, Montana. Her family moved to Twin Bridges in 1917 where they farmed on what was then the Hummel Ranch near Silver Star. She attended Twin Bridges school an graduated in 1925 and married Philip Cook on September 3, 1927.

Only July 7th, 1930 they entered into the hotel and cafe business, buying the Gould Hotel and Cafe. (What is now The Lost Cabin Bar and The Vault in Twin Bridges) By July 7, 1937

they moved to the site of the old Blue Front, which Phil had inherited from his father.

(Where the NAPA Store is Currently in Twin Bridges) There they remodeled the little place and made it into a small cafe. They later sold the Gould Hotel and it was turned into a garage. The Blue Front was said to be the place to go as it was way ahead of it's time. It featured the first Juke box and had excellent food. During this time their family grew and they had a son on December 7th, 1932 (William) Miles Cook) and a daughter on November 11, 1940 (Suzanne Reavley Cook).

When World War 2 came along, Phil joined the Navy and ended up in Bremerton, Washington working in the Navy Yard. Jemima temporally

closed the Blue Front and joined her husband in Washington and worked at a day care. When the war ended they both returned to Twin Bridges and re-opened the cafe throwing a big party for every returning vetern.

In 1948 they purchased what was the Masonic Building which was located right next to the little Blue and remodeled this bigger building turning it into the Blue Anchor Bar and Cafe and meeting house. It is pretty much the same today as it was when then first opened. It became well known for quality food, including smorgasbords, Sunday dinners, banquets and a great place to hold parties.

On June 28th, 1963, Phil died of a heart attack and this was a big loss not only for his family, but for the community as well. He had raised money for local groups, was involved with community activities and always had a hand up for those that needed it. Jemima continued operating the business until 1969 when she decided to sell and "retire".

Since retiring, Jemima went on to manage the Watuck Lodge in Cooke City and later was a manager for the Wells Fargo Coffee House in Virginia City. In 1971 she taught food service to the junior high home economics at the Children's Center through the Twin Bridges High School. Later she was drafted as the Mayor of Twin Bridges. When she retired from that she went on to work as a secretary-manager for the Madison County Fair.

She had belonged to the Order of Eastern Star, Elks Does, 500 Club, Bridge Club and Garden Club in Twin Bridges. She had also been president of the Twin Bridges Parent-Teachers Association. She suffered from cancer and passed away July 12, 1988.

Jemima Cook sold the Blue Anchor on April 29th, 1969 to Bob and Doris Lovejoy. It was later sold to Bob Graham in 1980, Dan and Dottie Wiggins in 1993 and later Leslie Adams. Currently the legacy lives on at the Blue Anchor as it is still open and operated by Debbie Burke and crew.
